**Southern Nevada Adult Mental Health Services (SNAMHS)** is currently seeking a **Medical Director** for our Hospital located in Las Vegas, Nevada. SNAMHS is a State of Nevada agency whose Mission is to help adults with mental illness improve their quality of life, by providing inpatient and outpatient mental health services for people living in our community. We are committed to developing innovative programs and service delivery systems. Some of the services we provide include Psychiatric Emergency Services, Inpatient Services, Mobile Crisis, Outpatient Counseling, Service Coordination, Intensive Service Coordination, Medication Clinic, Psychosocial Rehabilitation, Residential Support Programs, Mental Health Court, Senior Outreach, and Programs for Assertive Community Treatment (PACT) teams. Inpatient services are provided through the new, state-of-the-art Rawson-Neal Psychiatric Hospital, which began serving our community on August 28, 2006. Outpatient services are provided through four mental health clinics located throughout the community, with a fifth clinic scheduled to open soon. We are accredited by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) and by the Joint Commission on Accreditation of Health Care Organizations.

**DESCRIPTION:** The incumbent is responsible for the clinical administration of psychiatric services for the Agency. As a senior leader will work jointly with the Hospital Administrator to manage and direct the inpatient medical staff of a 234 bed facility, while ensuring regulatory and Joint Commission compliance. Manage and provide guidance to the Associate Medical Director who is responsible for the outpatient medical staff, located in four community clinics. Direct the Resident training and Internship programs, with possible University Medical School affiliation.

**EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE:** Applicants must be Board Certified/Board Eligible Psychiatrists, having at least five (5) years of experience in a responsible position within a mental health setting and be eligible for licensure in the State of Nevada. Must possess and maintain NV Licensure, DEA certification and State Board of Pharmacy certification. Fingerprinting and a background investigation through the FBI and NHP are required. The employee is responsible for all associated fees.

**SPECIAL NOTES AND REQUIREMENTS:** NRS 433.267 requires Psychiatrists employed by the Division of Mental Health and Mental Retardation be certified by the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology within five years from the date of employment.

**SALARY AND BENEFITS:** Potential earnings up to \$192,000. Excellent benefits package including health, dental and vision insurance, Public Employees Retirement Plan, three weeks paid vacation, three weeks sick leave, paid holidays and no state, county, city or social security tax!
