SUBJECT: CLASSES/POSITIONS APPROVED FOR PRE-EMPLOYMENT
DRUG TESTING & PROGRAM UPDATE

NRS 284.4066 provides for the pre-employment drug testing of applicants for positions affecting public safety. As a result of actions taken at the May 12, 2006 and August 11, 2006 Personnel Commission meetings, the list of classes and positions approved for such testing has been revised and updated.

It has recently come to our attention that some forms used for drug and alcohol testing may be out dated. Please check your supply of forms and if they do not list the State Contracted MRO – Dr. Joseph Johnson on them, please contact Quest at 800-877-7484 to get a new supply of forms and discard your old stock.

In addition to the above request, we also need your help with ensuring the collection of accurate data. Unfortunately a large number of tests conducted have not included the purpose of the testing. Please ensure when an applicant or employee is sent for testing the person completing the lab form has checked the appropriate box, (e.g., pre-employment, reasonable suspicion/cause, etc.). Additionally, please remember to mark the split sample box, so a second test may be performed should it be requested.

For your convenience, we have also updated the list of collection sites for Controlled Substance Testing, along with the instruction page on how to properly utilize drug-testing sites.

Collection Sites for Controlled Substance Testing

Quest Diagnostics provides sample collection services for drug and alcohol testing through a nationwide network of sites. It is important to obtain services from either a Quest Diagnostics lab or one of their Partner or Third Party sites in order to receive the contracted price. On the following pages, there is a list of collection sites and their designation:

- (S) Quest
- (P) Partner/Preferred Third Party
- (O) Third Party

Additionally, you may access the most current test site locations by visiting Quest Diagnostics' web site and following the procedure listed below.

- Click on "Find a Quest Diagnostics Location (left side of screen)
- This will bring up the "Find a Location" page "
- Enter City, and State (and if necessary proximity)
- Under Reason for Testing, select Drug/alcohol screening
- That will bring up a new field, select a non-regulated employer
- That will bring up another new field, select Urine drug screen
- Hit the "Search" button

Remember, if there is a Quest site available in your area, it must be utilized, if not, then a Partner/Preferred Third Party can be used. Lastly, if neither of those are available in your area, use a Third Party site. When using a Third party site, it is recommended that you call prior to using the facility, to ensure they are still a collection site.

The radius search is preset to 15 miles. If a site does not appear after hitting the "Search" button you will need to increase the miles in your radius search. For most work locations, there will be a collection site nearby. If you have any questions regarding available collection sites, you may call Quest customer service at 1-800-877-7484.
